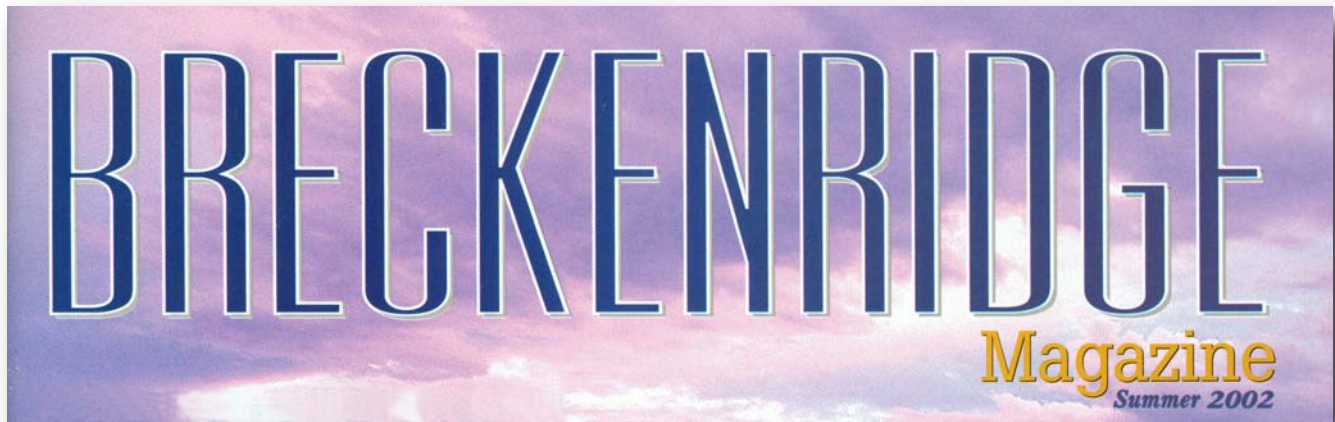
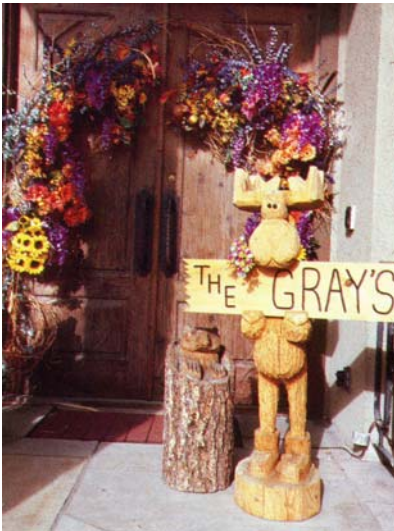

This Breckenridge residence exudes a genuine welcoming aura that is naturally characteristic of its owners. The attention to detail, the personalized touches, the casual,

True to the French country style, the kitchen's massive center island exhibits natural, wire brushed, white pine cabinetry with a white-wash finish. The recessed cook stove area is accented with colorful Italian tiles and surrounded by a Colorado sandstone arch, which serves as a dramatic focal point for the kitchen.



In the Gray's home, this area conveys a sense of comfortable elegance. The dining area backdrop displays ornate beveled windows overlooking the downstairs pool area, yet allowing natural light to stream in.

The Gray's living room exhibits an open, inviting floor plan. "The living room is my favorite part of this home. I really enjoy just sitting on the couch, gazing toward the stairs and taking in the workmanship and drama of the exposed trusses. With the 30 foot ceilings, the clear span of the beams is magical and just creates a very open feel", emphasizes Reggie.

The massive trusses were originally square douglas fir beams which were hand hewn, and drilled and bolted together on site.

Three substantial decks converge along the home's exterior with a hot tub situated upon the deck adjoining the breakfast nook. This outdoor entertaining area also allows the Gray's to take in the fabulous views of Peaks 7, 8, and 9 and the scenery surrounding their mountain home.
